OUTDOOR SKILLS REQUIRED PRIOR TO PINE TREE

MUST SIGN AND TURN IN WITH APPLICATION

Pine Tree Candidates: must be proficient in outdoor and camp skills prior to attending the course. Skills will not be taught on the course as it is expected that each candidate have the skills to set up camp and perform the functions of cooking meals, proper sanitation, fire building, first aid, use of woods tools, lashing, and map and compass, which include:

1. Packing the correct gear and carrying it correctly.
2. Picking a suitable location and pitching a tent correctly.
3. Making a comfortable, dry bed on the ground inside the tent and sleeping on it.
4. Follow good health, sanitation and safety practices ... leave a clean camp.
5. Whip the end of a rope. Tie the following knots and show their correct use:
Square knot, sheet bend, two half hitch, clove hitch, taut-line hitch, bowline.
6. Lash poles together with the following lashes: Square sheer, and diagonal lashings. Show correct use for each lash. Use lashing for making a simple useful camp gadget.
7. Show by what you do that you follow the outdoor code.
8. Sharpen a knife and ax properly and give rules for safe use. Use a knife, ax and saw correctly to prepare tinder, kindling and firewood.
9. Locate and prepare a suitable fire site. Build and light a cooking fire using not more than two matches.
10. In the outdoors, prepare a complete breakfast, lunch, and dinner, making sure that it is on time and edible. After cooking and eating these meals, properly clean utensils, dispose of garbage, and store mess gear leaving a clean cooking area.
11. Be prepared to use all skills taught in the first aid skill award and the first aid merit badge.
12. Be prepared to use a map and compass and understand all of their functions.
